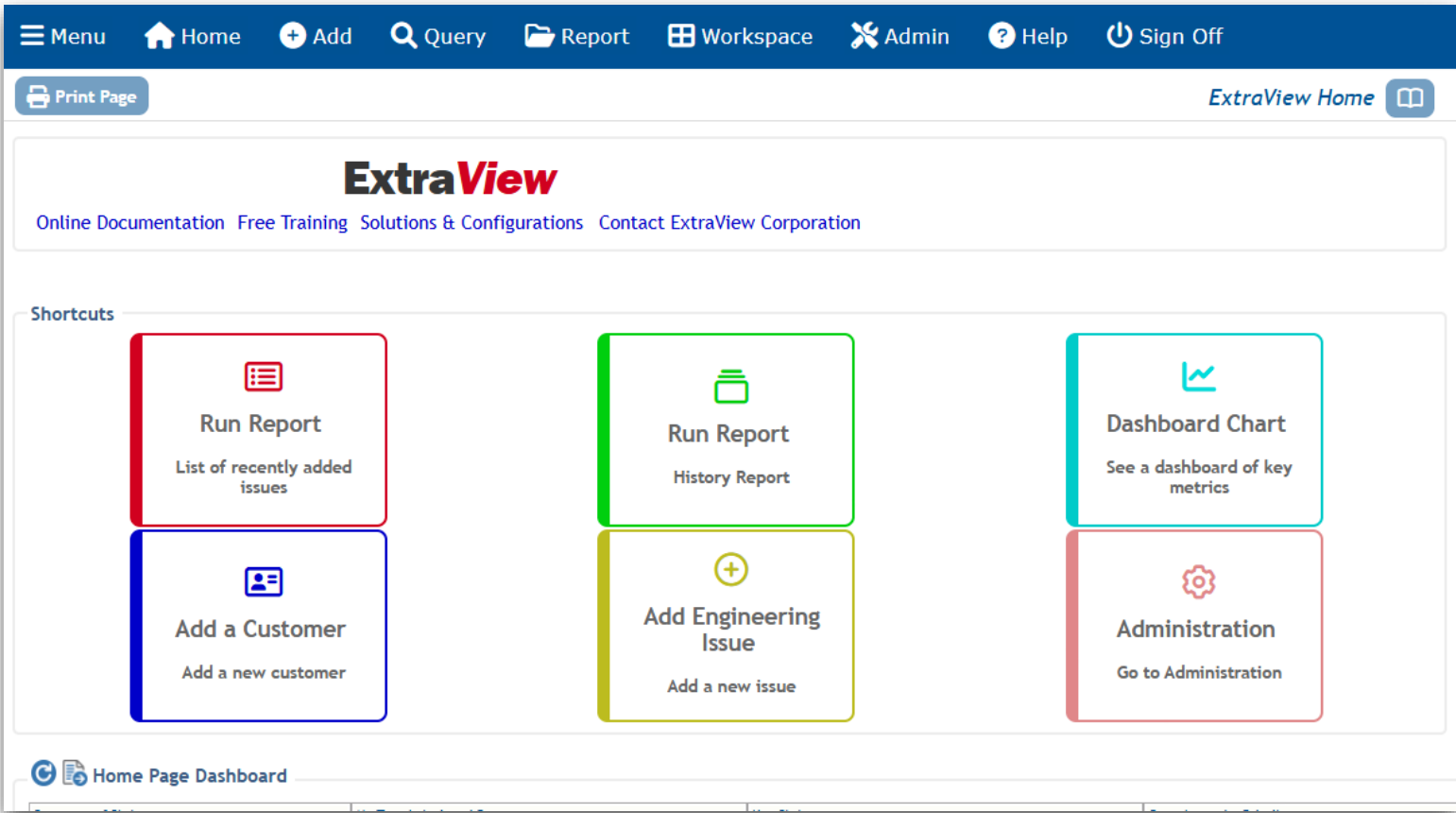
Workflow

- There are new capabilities to define one or more Home Page layouts. These layouts are configured with action shortcut buttons to perform tasks such running reports, adding issues and displaying key metrics
- On *add* and *edit* layouts, the user search capability now supports searching by using a user's email address
- The inline add feature to add related issues within *add* and *edit* screens renders all fields with the same user interface as the fields on the main layouts
- Any DATE or DAY field can use a multi-month calendar picker popup as opposed to only being able to view and select from a single month
- Related issues can be created directly from within EDIT_RID layouts on *edit* screens
- Complete rows within EDIT_RID layouts can now be hidden with a single layout cell attribute

Workflow (continued)

- Reports of related issues may now be included within an Email Templated definition for outgoing email notifications

Reporting

- A user's *Favorites* reports may now be placed under a new button defined on the Navigation Bar, providing quicker access to these reports
- History reports have been enhanced to allow the specification of a start date when viewing history over a family of related issues
- Attachments may now be excluded from the output on History reports
- Mass update operations from reports have been enhanced to better determine a user's intentions as to the business area and project to use for the operation
- The *Records per Page* option for history audit trails from *edit* screens has been separated from the *Records per Page* option for all other reports. This allows better control for installations where there may be thousands of updates within the audit trail of a single issue

Reporting (continued)

- New ability to sort and resort comment (logarea) fields on browser report output
- The Attachments section of History reports can be suppressed on History reports

Administration

- The creation and maintenance for all types of buttons and their styles have been consolidated into a single screen, greatly simplifying their administration
- The creation of many layout cell attributes within layouts has been simplified:
 - Attributes used in a similar way are grouped together in a single popup to allow them all to be selected at one time. E.g. all the styling for lists can be accomplished in a single place
 - When a color is required, there is a popup color picker
 - The styling of individual values within lists is greatly enhanced
- There is a new layout cell attribute that allows the admin to hide both the label and the value with a single attribute
- User defined attribute fields within user account maintenance can be controlled by the user to simplify access to long lists

Administration (continued)

- Notification layouts now support attributes for STYLE, STYLE IF, LABEL_TAG and LABEL_TAG_IF
- LABEL fields have several improved features, including the ability to configure them with HTML and to control their presentation
- The user import utility now supports updating existing user accounts as well as creating new user accounts
- When an outgoing email notification exceeds a threshold size, the notification is now sent without attachments as opposed to failing
- When creating a new field from the Design Center, you can create Expressions, Screen types and Labels as well as UDFs
- The Fields and Attributes section of the Design Center is now fixed on the screen and does not scroll away

Administration (continued)

- The context menu available from fields on *add* and *edit* layouts now has two new options for administrators
 - Edit the current layout in the Design Center
 - Edit the definition of the current field in the Data Dictionary
- A new navigation bar button is available. User will see and be able to run any of their favorite reports from this button


Attribute STYLE

Use the **Preview** button to view how the button will be rendered for end users.

API

- The run_report API call has been extended to be operable within Web Services

Security

- The use of the HTML GET parameter within HTML forms has been eliminated in critical parts of the code to reduce the small chance of a bad actor trying to submit valid URLs to the ExtraView server. Note this precaution is in addition to other security measures that are in place
