Administration

- Restructuring of layout cell attribute administration to simplify and clarify the use of each attribute
- The *Attachment* section of an *add* or *edit* screen is now a layout, so it can be customized and placed anywhere on the screens
- The *Notification* section of an *add* or *edit* screen is now a layout, so it can be customized and placed anywhere on the screens
- New paging mechanism to break down a layout into separately displayed “pages” – useful for mobile, for questionnaire type and complex workflows with hundreds of fields on a layout
- Enhanced filtering for Interest Lists
- Enhanced filtering for Escalation Rules
- Extended permission control of user-defined fields on user administration screen – virtually all user fields have a permission key
- Rules can generate error messages in different languages

Administration (continued)

- Improved interface to Design Center
 - Tree structure displaying inheritance
 - Easier to find and copy layouts



Workspaces

- **Default workspaces can be set up by role, by an administrator**
- **Workspaces can be shared – public and private workspaces**
- **Drag-and-drop extended between different report types**

Workflow

- Ability to set up and rank collections of issues for multiple purposes
 - Uses drag-and-drop within a workspace
 - Automatically re-ranks all issue when you alter any issue's position
 - Used in Agile methodologies to prioritize work
 - Only available within workspaces

Reporting

- **Improved user interface for querying**
- **Improved user interfaces of report editors**
- **Improved presentation of column reports that contain fields from multiple repeating row layouts**
- **Summary and matrix reports can now aggregate the values of issues to produce a total value in a field, as opposed to a count of issue**
- **Improved appearance of planning reports**
- **Report management feature for administrators that allows the examination of all reports over all users and allows actions such as deletion and moving of reports**

General

- **The drilldown search box can now search for any text in the database, not just issue IDs**
- **Any text field may be encrypted in the database to enhance security at the database level**
- **Printing of reports has been improved by turning off the menubar before commencing the print, then turning it back on after printing**
- **Improved self-registration process for new users, both for mobile and desktop**
- **Password reset option, authenticated via email**

EVMail

- **Ability to parse incoming emails to extract information to be directed to specific fields within issues**

System-Level Enhancements

- **Support for Microsoft SQL Server 2012**
- **Support for MySQL 5.6**
- **Support for JBoss 7 application server**
- **EVMail direct connectivity to Microsoft Exchange servers**
- **Support for Servlet level 3.0**
